



Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)

Candidate must either hold a BCBA or be eligible to take the exam within three months. A minimum of 2 years' experience working with children with autism is required. Supervisory experience in any capacity is also required. This position is for our Richmond, VA location.

Join us to do ABA in a setting that values best practices, strong supervision, and supports both staff and client families. Job duties include: Providing assessments to new clients (ages 1-14), developing and overseeing client service plans, training and supervising staff in the implementation of service plans, meeting with client families to develop and review service plans, collaborating with schools and other service providers, completing all required documentation, and reviewing staff documentation for accuracy.

This is a full time, salaried position with a reasonable caseload that includes significant administrative support for many non-clinical aspects of the role. BCBA's have the opportunity to collaborate with other BCBA's on the team to ensure ethical decision making and best practices are in place. BCBA's also have the opportunity to increase their caseload size at their own discretion with salary increases to match. BCBA's can earn a weekly bonus based on their team's performance.
