## Positive Behavior Intervention and Support Program

Each Student will have a daily, weekly, and monthly behavioral point goal determined by the administrative team. Students making their monthly goal will be assigned to one of four levels as follows:

Monthly Point Average	Level	2016-17 Level System and Rewards
0-69	Working	
70-79	Smoking	
80-89	Glowing	
90-100	Fire	
	Blazing	2 consecutive months on Level 4
	Inferno	3 consecutive months on Level 4

Students will earn one “F.I.R.E. match” for each day that they meet their behavioral point goal and additional matches will be issued at the discretion of staff. When the student’s individual “matchbook” is filled, he/she may exchange their matchbook for rewards. Goals are met by following the school’s Positive Behavior Intervention Support program F.I.R.E. Guidelines (see page 2)

Matchbooks may be turned in for incentives– incentives may be toys, edibles, gift cards, or other special privileges and will be available from the school director

On a monthly basis, students will earn a one-time reward (a trip, lunch out, movie, or a party) based on their level. Students will be awarded wristbands of the color that corresponds to their level and may choose to wear their wristband on a daily basis. This is in addition to the incentives earned at each level of the behavioral system.

Points can be earned on a daily basis as follows:

<u>Arrives on time (or has excused tardy):</u>	<u>5 points</u>
<u>Attempts work and F.I.R.E. guidelines – morning</u>	<u>0-45 points</u>
<u>Attempts work and F.I.R.E. guidelines – afternoon</u>	<u>0-45 points</u>
<u>Remains out of Time Out for the entire Day:</u>	<u>5 points</u>

Once Points have been earned they may not be taken back

Once Matches have been earned they may not be taken back

## F.I.R.E. Guidelines:

**Focus:** Dominion Dragons are focused on working hard to improve academically, behaviorally, and emotionally in all aspects of school.

**Integrity:** Dominion Dragons demonstrate integrity by accepting their personal role in their own decisions on a daily basis, by exhibiting honesty, and by demonstrating a positive attitude in their use of language, body language, and attitude toward others.

**Respect:** Dominion Dragons demonstrate respect by conducting themselves in a way that shows that they care about the feelings and well-being of others as well as themselves.

**Effort:** Dominion Dragons demonstrate excellence in their effort toward academic, behavioral, emotional, and professional goals and through their efforts to try their hardest in all that they do.

Examples of being “on F.I.R.E.”

<b>F</b>	Exhibits a desire to learn and improve academically and behaviorally, remains on task.
<b>I</b>	Is honest and makes and exhibits a sense of fairness and morality in making choices. Encourages other to abide by rules. Demonstrates a positive attitude in use of language, body language, dress, and attitude towards others.
<b>R</b>	Uses respectful language and attitude, takes turns and practices active listening in interactions with others
<b>E</b>	Tries hard to complete class work and make positive behavior choices
